The Committee gave consideration to the letter written by Nigel Ozier that objected to the proposed development on clear planning grounds based upon DDC Saved Policies as supported by the NPPF and also listened to Mr. Ozier's explanation of his reasoning as a qualified Town Planner.

Mr. Michael Parsons also raised concerns about the ongoing capability of the surgery. This is already stretched and has yet to realise the impact of the Eaglehurst Development that is underway or the approved development of 150 houses East of Northampton Road. He produced a letter written by the Saxon Spires Patient Participation Group that also strongly objected to the Care Home application.

This being information the Committee did not have when first considering the application it was resolved to add to our original concerns by endorsing the objections laid out by Mr. Ozier and supporting the concerns raised about the surgery. It was agreed that the parish Council would write a letter to DDC to this effect, thus amplifying our original position. It was also resolved that Mr. Ozier would be asked to speak on behalf of the Parish Council at the DDC Planning Committee Meeting when the application was heard.
